Next year, I'm going to try to remember to encourage all to bring along an old spackle bucket or two - thanks, Howard!

I can't remember the last time we had clear skies and mild temperatures for the event - what a gorgeous day! Thanks go out to Will, Sean and John Martyn, and Leah, Launa and Justin Hall, in addition to Howard, for their participation.

Every time we do this, a few interesting things turn up in the haul, which was pretty impressive in spite of the previous Wednesday's storm. This time among the bottles, plastic bags and misc. trash we hauled-in a broken barbecue grill lid, a vintage-2000 Virginia license plate and (of particular interest to the stream cleanup chair who's also a railroad buff) a railroad track tie plate! 


WANTED: MMCA NEIGHBORHOOD WELCOME CHAIR




